- 1. complete a Notice of Objection Form,**
- 2. serve the applicant with the objection,**
- 3. file a copy of the objection and provide proof of service of the objection on the applicant with the Board,**
- 4. pay the appropriate fee.**

**Serving and filing an objection may be affected by hand delivery, mail, courier or facsimile. Serving means the date received by a party and filing means the date received by the Board.**
