Periodically, temporary applications are filed with the Board. Details of these applications can be made available at any time to any interested parties by calling (416) 326-6732.

Permanent:

The following are applications for extra-provincial and public vehicle operating licenses filed under The Motor Vehicle Transport Act, 1987, and the Public Vehicles Act. All information pertaining to the applicant i.e. business plan, supporting evidence, etc. is on file at the Board and is available upon request.

Any interested person who has an economic interest in the outcome of these applications may serve and file an objection within 29 days of this publication. The objector shall:

- 1. complete a Notice of Objection Form,**
- 2. serve the applicant with the objection,**
- 3. file a copy of the objection and provide proof of service of the objection on the applicant with the Board,**
- 4. pay the appropriate fee.**

Serving and filing an objection may be affected by hand delivery, mail, courier or facsimile. Serving means the date received by a party and filing means the date received by the Board.

Applies for an extra-provincial operating licence as follows:
(Formerly X-1639)

For the transportation of passengers on a chartered trip from points in the Province of Quebec from the Ontario/Quebec border crossings to points in Ontario and return of the same passengers

on the same chartered trip to point of origin.

PROVIDED that there be no pick up or discharge of passengers except at the point of origin.

Also extension granted:

For the transportation of passengers on a one way chartered trip from points in the Province of Quebec as authorized by the Province of Quebec to points in Ontario.

PROVIDED that:

a) the licensee be restricted to the use of Class "D" public vehicles as defined in paragraph (a) (iv) subsection 1 of Section 7 of Regulation 982 under The Public Vehicles Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.54;

b) there be no pick-up of passengers in Ontario.

Extension granted: (Formerly X-1783 - Transferred from Queensway Travel Tours Inc. - OHTB Sept. 3/96)

For the transportation of passengers on a chartered trip from points in the Regional Municipality of Ottawa-Carleton excluding the Township of Cumberland and the City of Vanier to the Ontario/Manitoba, Ontario/Québec and Ontario/U.S.A. border crossings for furtherance to points as authorized by the relevant jurisdiction and for the return of the same passengers on the same chartered trip to point of origin;

PROVIDED THAT the licensee shall be prohibited from operating chartered trips in school buses as defined in Section 175 (1) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8.

Extension granted: (Formerly X-3139 - Transferred from Howard Schutt Holdings Ltd. - OHTB Feb. 3/98)

For the transportation of passengers on a chartered trip from points in the County of Renfrew:

a) to the Ontario/Manitoba, Ontario/Québec and Ontario/U.S.A. border crossings for furtherance and return;

b) on a one way chartered trip to the Ontario/Manitoba, Ontario/Quebec and Ontario/U.S.A. borders for furtherance.

Extension granted:

For the transportation of passengers who are employees of the Department of National Defence on a chartered trip for and on behalf of the Department of National Defence from:

1) the City of Ottawa to the Ontario/Quebec border crossings for furtherance as authorized by the relevant jurisdiction to the City of Hull in the Province of Quebec;

(i) and for the return of same passengers on the same chartered trip to point of origin.

PROVIDED THAT there be no pick up or discharge of passengers except at point of origin.

(ii) on a one way chartered trip to points as authorized by the relevant jurisdiction.

2) The City of Hull in the Province of Quebec as authorized by the relevant jurisdiction from the Ontario/Quebec border crossings to the City of Ottawa

(i) and for the return of same passengers on the same chartered trip to point of origin.

PROVIDED THAT there be no pick up or discharge of passengers except at point of origin.

(ii) on a one way chartered trip to points as authorized by the relevant jurisdiction.

(OHTB Oct. 23/01)

Extension granted:

For the transportation of passengers on a chartered trip from points in the County of Lanark, lying on and north of King's Highway 7, to the Ontario/Quebec, Ontario/Manitoba and

Ontario/USA border crossings for furtherance to points as authorized by the relevant jurisdiction;
1) and for the return of the same passengers on the same chartered trip to point of origin;
2) on a one way chartered trip to points as authorized by the relevant jurisdiction.

(OHTB July 2/02)

Extension granted:

For the transportation of passengers on a one-way chartered trip from:

(i) The Montreal International Airport at Mirabel, the Montreal International Airport in Dorval, or the Jean-Lesage Airport in Quebec as authorized by the Province of Quebec from the Ontario/Quebec border crossings to the Lester B. Pearson International Airport or the Ottawa International Airport;

(ii) The Lester B. Pearson International Airport or the Ottawa International Airport to the Ontario/Quebec border crossings for furtherance to the Montreal International Airport at Mirabel, the Montreal International Airport in Dorval, or the Jean-Lesage Airport in Quebec.

PROVIDED THAT:

1) all such passengers shall have had a prior movement by air to point of origin and a subsequent movement by air at point of destination;

2) there shall be no additional charter privileges other than the privileges specifically conferred herein;

3) all such chartered trips shall originate in, and be returning to, Continental Europe.
